Balancing the Sword is a package including two books, software, and Web support. The two volumes streamline and enhance the learning process by utilizing:

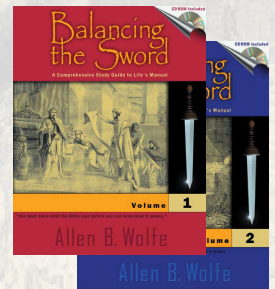
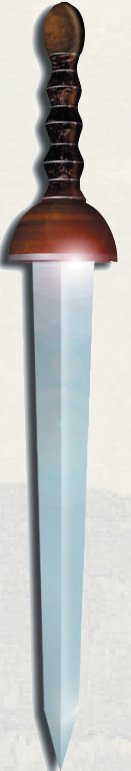
- over 7,000 **questions** with almost 13,000 parts (with answer keys) targeting every 2.7 verses on average,
