Dt. 29:11 - Making the Covenant in the Plains of Moab

Your **little ones**, your wives, and thy stranger that is in thy camp, from the hewer of thy wood unto the drawer of thy water:

Dt. 31:12 - Day of Atonement, Seventh Year, Reading of the Law

Gather the people together, men, and women, and **children**, and thy stranger that is within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:

2Ch. 20:13 - Gathered from All Cities to Pray in Temple because of Enemy Attack And all Judah stood before the LORD, with their **little ones**, their wives, and their **children**.

Ezr. 10:1

Now when Ezra had prayed, and when he had confessed, weeping and casting himself down before the house of God, there assembled unto him out of Israel a very great congregation of men and women and **children**: for the people wept very sore.

Ne. 8:2-3

And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and **all that could hear with understanding**, upon the first day of the seventh month. And he read therein before the street that was before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and **those that could understand**; and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law.

Ne. 10:28

And the rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the porters, the singers, the Nethinims, and all they that had separated themselves from the people of the lands unto the law of God, their wives, **their sons, and their daughters, every one having knowledge, and having understanding;**

Ne. 12:43

Also that day they offered great sacrifices, and rejoiced: for God had made them rejoice with great joy: the wives also and the **children** rejoiced: so that the joy of Jerusalem was heard even afar off.

Isa. 28:9

Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? **them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts**.

Joel 2:16

Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those

that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet.

Mt. 14:21

And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

Mt. 15:38

And they that did eat were four thousand men, beside women and children.

Lk. 18:15-16

And they brought unto him also **infants**, that he would touch them: but when his disciples saw it, they rebuked them. But Jesus called them unto him, and said, **Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not:** for of such is the kingdom of God.
